## خلاصه مقاله:

Korean architecture is one of the most successful architectural practices in the history of world architecture. Korean architecture has several periods in which the principles of architecture are different in shape and appearance. The last period is related to the ۱۴th century of the Joseon dynasty. In the present study, the history of Korean architecture related to the Joseon period has been considered in order to better understand Korean architecture and get acquainted with the buildings of the Joseon dynasty.
