Introduction: Child abuse is considered a significant public health problem that its different consequences can affect victim lifespan. This study was conducted to determine the frequency of child abuse in children referred to Kashan Social Emergency. Materials and Methods: This cross-sectional study was conducted by referring to child abuse records of Kashan Social Emergency during Y $_{\circ\circ}F$ to Y $_{\circ}F$. Data were analyzed with SPSS-IF and Fisher Exact and Chi-square tests. Results:The mean age of cases was $\Lambda \cdot \circ F \pm F.YA$ years. Among cases 19Y (Y1.F%) were neglect, $\Lambda \omega$ ($\mathfrak{P} \Delta \cdot F \otimes$) experienced emotional, ΛY ($\mathfrak{P} Y \cdot \Delta \otimes$) physical, and 1Y ($F.\Delta \otimes$) experienced sexual abuse. Among abused children, anxiety was reported as the most common complication of psychological abuse (1Y. $\mathfrak{P} \otimes$).
