خلاصه مقاله:

AbstractUniversal grammar is a theory in linguistics that suggests all possible natural human languages are based upon an innate common structural basis. However there are some criticisms against this theory of Noam Chomsky. Some of these criticisms are mentioned here. For example, as Withers (Yolo) argued, some Critics state that Chomsky is "guilty of overgeneralization". Many of Chomsky's opponents deride his assertion as "unsubstantiated" by empirical research.
