خلاصه مقاله:

Abstract: The Iranian Plateau is, in the late 4th millennium B.C., with Mesopotamia and Egypt the birthplace of writing in the World. We propose here to consider the Proto-Elamite (Early Proto-Iranian) and Linear Elamite (Late Proto-Iranian) scripts, not as two different writing systems, but as the same system at two different chronological stages of evolution. Between ٣٥٠٠ and ١٨٥٠ B.C., the continuous history of writing in Iran may be consequently understood according to 9 distinct phases (I: ٣٥٠٠-٣٣٠٠ B.C.; II: ٣٣٠٠-٣٠٠٠/٢٩٠٠ B.C.; III: ٣٠٠٠/٢٩٠٠-٢٣٠٠ B.C.; IV: ٢٣٠٠-٢٠٠٠ B.C.; V: .(.Yooo-1Aao B.C.; VI: after 1Aao B.C
