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خلاصه مقاله:

Objectives: The parent-child relationship is one of the strongest predictors of a child's adjustment during adulthood. Many hearing-impaired children have normal hearing families, and this issue adversely affects the parent-child relationship; however, studies on interventions have focused on high-risk clinical specimens. Methods: The effect of the Faranak parent-child program (Persian version of parent-child Mother Goose program) on the quality of mother-child relationship has been evaluated in this study, which involved families having preschool, hearing-impaired children. A group of 1°F mothers with hearing-impaired children participated in this 1°Y-week program. The control group received no training. Both groups were asked to complete the Gerrard parent-child questionnaire before and after the intervention program to assess their relationship with their children before and after the program. Results: The mothers who were part of the experiment group reported many positive changes in their relationship with the child during the program. Discussion: The Frank parent-child Mother Goose program could help families with hearing-impaired children in this 1°Y-week community-based program, wherein parents learned skills that affect the relationship .between mother and child
