Investigating Barriers to Nursing Process from the Perspective of Nurses and Nursing Managers: A Review Study

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خلاصه مقاله:

Introduction: Nursing Process is a critical thinking process in which a professional nurse uses the available evidence to care for and improve people's performance and respond to health and illness. Nursing process consists of five stages including nursing review, diagnosis, planning, implementation and evaluation, which as a dynamic process allows nurses to adjust their nursing services according to the changing needs of the client. **Methods:** In total, 35 articles with a time limit of the last 5 years were obtained by deleting 9 articles whose full text was not available; finally, 26 articles were included in the study. **Results:** In the field of individual barriers to the implementation of the nursing process, lack of complete knowledge of its concept and insufficient learning in this area is the most important factor of non-implementation. Many nurses and nursing managers are unfamiliar with the concept of nursing process; their side seems unreal. Contradiction is related to the field of education and clinical practice. Dry memorization education without a correct understanding of the practical concept of the nursing process is considered a major problem in the educational dimension of the nursing system. **Conclusion:** According to the many obstacles that exist for the implementation of the nursing process, nurses are expected to increase their knowledge regarding the concepts of the nursing process and nursing managers to overcome obstacles such as lack of time, lack of personnel, and the hospital's policy for implementing the nursing process.
