خلاصه مقاله:

Attention to the art and supporting talented and mighty artists have a long history in ancient Persia and art and artist have had privileged position among Iranians. Drawing various designs on potteries and the walls of caves in the prehistory era shows the importance of the art among the people of this country. Over time and with the mergence of other industries, Iranians had begun the creation of new arts and created beauty hand- made things with the support of local authorities which had a lot of demand among other countries and territories. In the Islamic era and particularly the Timurid period based on historical documents, most of Timurid kings including Timur and Shahrukh to Baysonqor Mirza and Shah Sultan Husayn Mirza, all had been lovers of art and patron of knowledge and culture and always artists and poets had a privileged status in the court of them.
