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## خلاصه مقاله:

The third leading cause of death worldwide is cancer and is projected that by 2030, there will be about 26 million new cancer cases and 7 million cancer deaths per year. The global distribution of cancer continues to change, especially in economically developing countries that include many countries in the Middle East and North Africa regions. Low- and middle-income countries are projected to account for about 60% of all cancers worldwide by 2050. The projected increase will be driven mainly by growth and aging populations in the Middle East populations. Unfortunately, practically no preventive care culture exists in many of the Middle Eastern countries facing the projected increased rate of cancer in the coming decades. Another major problem in the Middle Eastern countries is high prevalence of cancer-promoting behavior such as smoking and a sedentary lifestyle. It is highly recommended that cancer prevention programs which include practical national policies, mass screening, early detection, education programs, access to effective treatments should start soon in many of the Middle East countries facing projected increased cancer incidence in their populations.
