## خلاصه مقاله:

During the last ten years, oncoplastic conservative breast surgery has transitioned from being a pioneering technique to a mature one. In the beginning, there were only a few techniques available, which were strict applications of reduction mastopexy. A synergistic confrontation between carcinologic and plastic surgeons has led us to modify these techniques and also to create some totally new ones, such as the omega or external technique, for example. This was really an enthusiastic period, which has allowed for the creation of a complete panel of different techniques, now available quadrant per quadrant. These techniques induce a double benefit for patients, with more conservative surgery and better aesthetic results. Indications have also improved a lot, allowing for separation between simple and complex cases: Simple cases (or level 1 oncoplasty) concerns 70% of patients, and can be defined by the absence of areolar displacement, with aesthetic incisions and different types of direct glandular flaps to fill the glandular defect. Complex cases (level 2 oncoplasty) concerns 30% of patients and requires an experienced surgeon, able to perform all of the different techniques. Complication rates are obviously a little bit higher, but aesthetic results are usually very good.
