Cross-cultural Study of Metadiscourse Markers in English and Persian Political Newspaper Articles

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خلاصه مقاله:

The current study investigated the interactive and interactional metadiscourse markers in English and Persian newspaper articles. To this end, a corpus of English and Persian political newspaper articles published around the topic of Iran nuclear deal was analyzed based on Hyland's (2005) model of interactive and interactional metadiscourse markers. The findings indicated that metadiscourse markers were presented in both corpora; however, the distribution of metadiscourse markers was different. Results revealed that both interactive and interactional metadiscourse markers were used more frequently in English corpus rather than Persian corpus. In addition, the findings of the statistical analysis showed endophoric markers of interactive category were only present in the Persian corpus. Moreover, there were no statistically significant differences in using code glosses in both corpora. Also, transitions, evidentials and frame markers were used more frequently in the English corpus. With regard to the interactional category, hedges, attitude markers and engagement markers were used more frequently in English corpus than Persian corpus.
